

NGA ships firearms and components via United Parcel Service (UPS) ground, 3day select in accordance with UPS shipping regulations.

Just-purchased firearms will be shipped only to federally licensed importers\*, dealers\*, collectors\* and/or manufacturers\*, law enforcement agencies and/or departments and other agencies of the United States, or any State law enforcement agency and/or department.

Firearms being returned to the owner after factory repair will be shipped directly to the owner.

Firearms and ammunition must be packaged separately for transportation. A packaged firearm cannot be labeled to indicate that it contains a firearm, either assembled or unassembled—UPS will not accept packages containing firearms that are labeled as containing firearms for shipping.\*\* Small arms ammunition must be transported in accordance with the United States Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 49.173.63.b2, and must be labeled “ORM-D” and the contents must be declared by their proper shipping name\*\*\* on the outside container in a manner that is clearly visible and legible, in compliance with CFR 49.172.316.

Please check firearms laws in your state before shipping firearms and/or ammunition either intrastate or interstate.

\* Firearms can only be shipped to individuals certified by the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (BATFE) with a Federal Firearms License (FFL) in accordance with the United States Gun Control Act of 1968 (Public Law 90-618, enacted 22 October 1968) as amended by the Firearms Owners' Protection Act (Public Law 99308, enacted 19 May 1986, amended Public Law 99-360, 8 July 1986).
